Bobby Laurie currently serves as host of the nationally syndicated travel and lifestyle talk show "The Jet Set." Additionally, he can be seen and heard in the Washington, D.C. market as a Traffic Anchor and Reporter for ABC7 (WJLA-TV), Bloomberg, WBAL News Radio and iHeartRadio.

Bobby has extensive experience in the travel industry. In 2005 he was hired as flight attendant for US Airways and later moved up the ranks to work alongside the Federal Aviation Administration where he developed emergency protocols in use today at American Airlines. He left the aviation side of the industry in 2015 after helping to launch Sir Richard Branson's American airline venture "Virgin America." In 2017 he was hired as a traffic reporter for iHeart Radio in Washington, D.C. by associating his travel experience to the needs and modes of transport of the everyday commuter. Later, Bobby was hired as a traffic producer for FOX5 (WTTG) in Washington, D.C. to source and confirm traffic incidents and create graphic maps for the morning anchor to present. By the end of 2017, Bobby had gained a wholesome understanding of television traffic reporting and left FOX5 to begin as a fill-in Traffic Anchor for ABC7 (WJLA).
