BL started her radio career in the late 80's as a part-time call screener and daily on-air talent for the nationally syndicated Ron & Ron Radio Network. The five years spent with Ron & Ron inspired BL to co-create and co-host Hooters on the Radio, which ran for three years in the '90's under the watchful eye of Ron Bennington.

In 1995 EXTRA filmed a segment featuring Hooters on the Radio. The late Jim Paratore, President of Telepictures saw the show and signed BL to a one-year hold \$10,000 contract. The intent was to create a new television talk show. BL was one of the three finalists picked to be the host. It was an honor to be considered but the show eventually went to Rosie O'Donnell.

In the late 90's BL co-founded and hosted The SportsChix on CBS Radio Tampa. She represented CBS Radio on radio row, through eight Super Bowls, the Kentucky Derby and various other sports related venues.

BL not only enjoys a good working relationship with a variety of top name athletes and celebrities but counts many as friends. She has conducted over a hundred interviews with top names including Dan Marino, Wayne Gretzky, Jim Kelly, Cris Carter, Chris Berman, Pete Rose, the late Deacon Jones and others.
